GENERAL INFORMATION

1. There will be two groups Junior (8 years to 14 years)and Senior(above 14 Years) for participations.
2. In Dance /Music the participants may be accompanied with three Accompanists on instruments. Harmonium, violin or sitar, Tablas/Dholak will be provided if required.
3. One participant can participate in two cultural competitions and two sports competitions only. Specimen of entry form is enclosed, The schools should send separate form for each event.
4. The rules and regulations for the sports events shall be as per norms of games for the Handicapped.
5. The schools can send one participant each for competitions for Braille reading and Braille writing for junior/senior groups.
6. The Schools must select the best participant(s) for the competitions.
7. Boarding, lodging and local transport will be made available at Patiala from 26th Dec Afternoon to 30th Dec Morning. The teams will be reporting at Thapar University Patiala. For enquiries contact 9779074839, 9872796366.
8. Confirmed mode of travelling and reaching time must be informed to us well in time so that the teams may be received at railway station/ bus stand.
9. Traveling Allowance (Railway/Bus fare) will be reimbursed on submission of original tickets only as per Handicap concession rate. The schools may keep the photocopies of the tickets with them.
10. The teams coming from south/west/east INDIA may reach PATIALA via DELHI, AMBALA.
11. Last Date of Confirmation with filled up forms is 12th DEC 2016. Forms can be downloaded from our website and filled forms can be sent on email
12. If participants are on some medicines the schools should bring the sufficient quota of medicines with them.
13. The climate of Patiala will be very cold therefore, woolen clothes must be brought by the participants.
14. The team incharge accompanying the team must bring his/her photo identity proof.
15. The decision of panel of judges/referees will be final and binding for awards.
16. We are making efforts for bringing teams from SAARC countries also.
17. During Festival the participants in cultural/sports competitions may also participate in fun games like Bocce, Ring Gola, Musical Chairs, Painting, Rangoli & Knitting. Please bring material where ever it is required.
18. Tug of war and a cultural meet for teachers will be organized on 28th December.
19. Wide publicity will be given in print and on TV media in respect of all the events and participating schools.
20. If any team wishes to visit the tourist places nearby we may facilitate in organizing the tour at the COST of interested schools, if prior information is given to us.

PRIZES

- For the competitions in cultural events prizes will be given in cash Rs. 5,000/-, Rs. 3,000/- & Rs. 2,000/- for the 1st, 2nd & 3rd positions respectively. For group/team events the prizes will be Rs. 16,000/-, Rs. 12,000/- & Rs. 8,000/- for the 1st, 2nd & 3rd positions respectively.
- The Winning participants in Sports will be given the Gold, Silver and Bronze medals respectively along with the Trophies.
- All the participants in festival will be given the certificate of Participation.
- The school which will win the maximum number of prizes overall will be honored with Over all Trophy. The school which gets the 2nd best position will be honored with Runners up trophy.

Note:- Maximum Number Of Participants Per School Will Be 10(Ten) Only.

BLIND STUDENTS

RULES FOR CULTURAL EVENTS

(A) Group Song for Junior and Senior groups both

- (A) The song should be non filmy
- (B) The self composed song will get three extra points
- (C) It should be based on any of the following themes
 - (i) National Integration/Communal Harmony
 - (ii) Women Empowerment
 - (iii) Cleanliness/ Swachh Bharat
 - (iv) Literacy
 - (v) Save Natural Resources
 - (vi) Any other Social Issue
- (D) The time should not exceed five (5) minutes.
- (E) The number of Participants should not exceed Eight (8) Students.
- (F) Male and Female students combined are allowed in the groups.
- (G) The groups will be allowed to perform with three music instruments. Harmonium, Tablas/Dholak and Violin/Sitar) will be provided if required.

(B) Solo Singing Vocal for Junior and Senior Groups Separately

- (i) One Male/ Female student can participate.
- (ii) The Singer will present one classical and one folk song and judgment will be based on both collectively.
- (iii) The time for each song will be three to five (3 to 5) minutes.

(c) Musical Instruments only for Senior Group

- 1. Only one participant either girl or boy for competitions of playing Tablas.
- 2. Only one Participant either girl or boy for playing Harmonium/Violin/Guitar/Flute/Sitar is allowed.
- 3. Time for musical instruments will not exceed three to five(3 to 5)minutes.

(D) Braille Writing and Reading Competitions:-

- (i) There shall be only one participant either boy or girl for junior and senior category each.
- (ii) The language used for competitions can be Hindi or English.
- (iii) The Judgment will be done on speed and writing mistakes of the students.
- (iv) The Judgment will be on speed and pronunciations of the students in reading .
- (v) The Judgment for both writing and reading will be completed for declaration the 1st, 2nd & 3rd positions in both the categories VIZ Junior and Senior groups.
- (vi) The time for writing will not exceed 15 minutes for Junior group and 10 minutes for Senior group . Time for reading for Senior group will be 5 minutes and for Junior group will be 7 minutes.
