Early Intervention for Deaf Infants

Introduction

Ref. No.....

- Early Intervention for Deaf Infants is a new concept in the Indian system which consist of training the Parent and Child born deaf. This system has proved successful in various advanced countries. In India this system is still in its infancy stage with only one center in Chennai.
- Testing of infants for hearing was not the Govt. of India priority earlier. But now testing of infants for deafness is mandatory for all hospitals and Nursing homes. This is to be recorded on the discharge slip. <u>Aim</u>
- Aim of Early Intervention is to make the Infant improve his residual hearing capacity and to develop speech with help of parents.

Early Intervention

- 4. Parents are children's first teachers. Through play, communication, and touch, parents convey love to their child as well as information about the world. During everyday interaction parents teach their children names of objects, how things work, what is safe, and other lessons. These early experiences prepare a child for the long struggle.
- 5. When parents find out their child is deaf or hard of hearing, they may be unsure of what to do. Most parents want help.
- Thus Early intervention system is to train them from birth to three 3
 years of age to improve residual hearing to enable them to hear and
 talk.
- Services and plans are individual based on the needs of the child and family. Teaching is designed to support each child's development in the communication, hearing and speaking.

Individual plan services

 Early intervention is based on "Individualized Family Service Plan" (IFSP). Parents play an active role in the development of the IFSP. It is mandatory for a parent to be present at each session of training.

 - Speech language pathologist service room
 - Sound system room
 - Physical therapy room
 - Medical services room
